

## Z Achievement Award Reflection ~ Instructions

- 1) Include a picture of you on the first page of your report (your story will inspire others!)
- 2) Provide an overview of your creative and action oriented project
  - What is the title of your project? (give it a descriptive, catchy title)
  - What was the purpose of your project?
  - Describe your project - what did you do?
  - What are the observable and measurable results that demonstrate you have “achieved success”?
- 3) Describe how you demonstrated specific Lominger skills as you completed your project (The Lominger skills descriptions can be accessed through the Club Z Canvas – see link below. You may also reflect on the General Education Abilities for your campus – search your campus website for a list of these skills)
- 4) How does this project demonstrate critical thinking, creativity and/or innovation?
- 5) How does this project demonstrate entrepreneurship, social entrepreneurship, sustainability, diversity and inclusion, service learning, civic engagement, fine arts, research and/or positive social change? (most projects can be easily linked to entrepreneurial behaviors – ask for assistance, if needed)
- 6) If this Club Zeitgeist project is also a class assignment, please attach the directions/requirements for the assignment along with the title of the class and your instructor's name
- 7) How is the experience of completing this project of value to you as part of your student success journey?
- 8) How is the experience of completing this project of value to you as part of your career success and/or life success journey?
- 9) What has been most important/rewarding to you about completing your Club Zeitgeist Achievement?
- 10) If you were to talk with a new student within the Maricopa County Community Colleges, what would you tell them about how Club Z might help them work toward their personal definition of success?
