The Accreditation Council for Education in Nutrition and Dietetics (ACEND)® Board has been closely monitoring the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on ACEND accredited programs and in doing so is considering the long-term implications on the accreditation process. Most site visits scheduled to occur in 2020 have been postponed and ACEND volunteer reviewers may not be able to fully resume travel to complete these site visits until 2021.

With this in mind, at its April 13, 2020 meeting, the ACEND Board voted to extend your program's accreditation term one year. Your program's new accreditation term end date is **December 31, 2024** and your program's next site visit will occur **August-December 2023**. This extension will not impact the length of your program's next seven-year accreditation term.

You will receive more information about scheduling the site visit approximately one year in advance of the site visit.
