



## Paramedic to RN Bridge Program (NUR106) Fact Sheet

The Paramedic to RN Bridge Program (NUR106) includes coursework that will provide paramedics with the theory and clinical competencies to successfully progress into the second or third Block of the MaricopaNursing program. This program is 9 credits and includes in-person lectures and labs, online components, and structured clinical experiences at local hospitals and medical centers.

NUR106 will be offered at Paradise Valley Community College (PVCC) in the **Fall** and at Mesa Community College (MCC) in **Spring** each year.

Successful completion of NUR106 will meet eligibility requirements for Advanced Placement into the second or third Block of the Nursing Program. You must complete the Advanced Placement Application Packet for Paramedic Applicants



### Eligibility Requirements

- High School Diploma or GED
- Official Transcripts - Request that all official colleges/universities transcripts be sent to college of anticipated participation (NOTE: Credit by Evaluation or PLA is required for vocational or non-credit courses or courses taken at non-accredited institutions):

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- General Education Courses - Courses must be **completed** before application deadline; minimum grade required is a "C"
  - CHM130 & CHM130LL Fundamental Chemistry with lab or one-year high school Chemistry
  - BIO201 Human Anatomy and Physiology I
  - BIO202 Human Anatomy and Physiology II
  - ENG101 First Year Composition
  - MAT 140, 141, 142 or higher
  - NUR187 Pharmacology & Med Administration II or equivalent (NCE170)
    - Must be completed prior to submitting an application and within 12 months of start date
  - BIO205 Microbiology
    - It is highly recommended to complete prior to AAS program entry
- HESI A2 Admission Exam - see score requirements in the admission packet.
- Level One Fingerprint Clearance Card (FCC) - Application and instructions available online at <https://www.azdps.gov/>. Allow 8 to 10 weeks to receive the FCC.
- Arizona or National Paramedic Registry Certificate - submit a copy of current, valid and unrestricted certificate.
