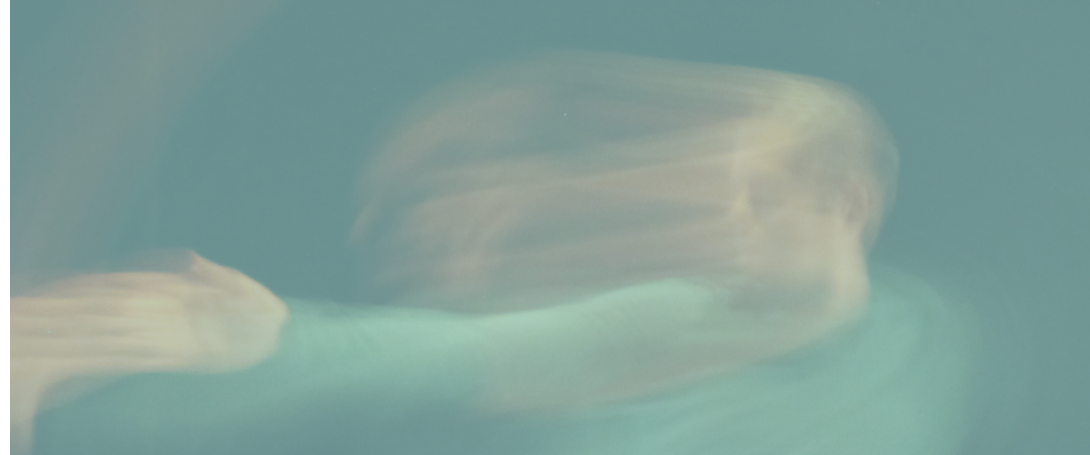

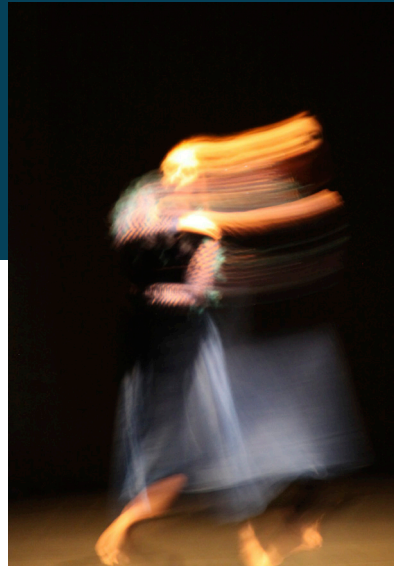
MAKE A LIVING DOING WHAT YOU LOVE

PERFORMANCE

The PVCC Dance Company is the college's student repertory dance company, providing dance students pre-professional experience in repertory pieces choreographed by the Company, faculty, and guest artists.

CHOREOGRAPH

Students who aspire to become choreographers in schools, studios, arts-in-education programs, or for dance and theater companies take classes that explore the basic elements of dance through sapce, time and energy.

EDUCATION/TEACHING

Dancers can become teachers and mentors. They teach the technique and artistry of dance and kinetic movement to students in public and private schools from pre-kindergarten through 12th grade or instruct students with special needs.

TECHNICAL/PRODUCTION

Students get behind-the-scenes experience to learn the technical and organizational aspects of stage production.

DANCE ADMINISTRATION

The program prepares students who aspire to work as an administrator for a dance company or dance camp, or hope to one day open their own studio.
