

Need a TB Health Card?

Are you required to obtain TB clearance for an employer, school, or to perform volunteer work?

The Maricopa County Department of Public Health TB Control and Prevention Program offers TB screening and a health card for only \$65.

Based on your medical history and symptoms, you may be screened and tested for TB using a skin test or a blood test, and a chest x-ray may be performed, as determined by the program's clinical staff.

TB Health Cards are available on a walk-in basis, and no appointment is necessary.

Please Note: TB skin tests will require you to return to the clinic 48-72 hours after the skin test is placed; for this reason, skin tests are not administered on Thursdays or on Fridays if the following Monday is a holiday.

Blood testing for TB does not require a return visit for results and is available any time during clinic hours.

We accept the following forms of payment: Cash, MasterCard, VISA or American Express. Sorry, we do not accept personal checks and we do not bill insurance companies.
