THE VISUAL ARTS PROGRAM AT PVCC

PVCC has a plan for fine arts students who aspire to earn a four-year degree. The Fine Arts Transfer Program at PVCC provides students with the academic preparation they need for successful transfer into a university fine arts program.

The Fine Arts Transfer Program is designed to help students select a course of study equivalent to the first two years at a university. The program introduces students to various disciplines and is geared to a wide-array of interests, including: Design and Animation, Painting and Drawing, and Ceramics and Sculpture. It is recommended that students with specific career goals speak to a Fine Arts advisor for detailed information.

PVCC Fine Arts students earn 63 transfer credits and enter into university as a junior, prepared with the technical skills to succeed. Students may navigate the program at their own pace and as their schedules permit, graduating in as soon as two years.

PVCC provides students with opportunities to exhibit their artwork and to engage in community projects. Upon completion of the program, students compile a creative portfolio showcasing their artwork.
