- How you applied academic or intellectual skills to this endeavor

This endeavor could involve an intellectual challenge, research problem, ethical dilemma, barrier or something that impacted you personally. It may be rooted in community/service learning, research, the arts, journalism, advocacy, public affairs, etc. Judges consider originality, initiative, degree of difficulty, results and benefit to society. Limit your essay to **ONE** specific endeavor. Do not include web links or photos in the text box.

### **Letter of Recommendation**

The Letter of Recommendation gives judges an expanded picture of the applicants leadership accomplishments as well as civic involvement. This document should be submitted within the parameters that outline both the format and the content of the assessment. Letters of recommendation that have been requested by the applicant via the Phi Theta Kappa website are not acceptable and will not be considered.

The Letter of Recommendation should speak to leadership and should showcase specific examples of how you have demonstrated leadership abilities, service involvement, and impact outside the classroom. This recommendation should specifically address the leadership example you discussed in your "significant endeavor" essay. Failure to provide a leadership example and commentary on the essay response may make your scholarship application less competitive. The letter of recommendation should be completed by a college faculty member, administrator, dean, or an employer or professional at an organization where you have volunteered.
